CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
FEBRUARY 17, 2010**

PRESENT: Parent, Bohnen, Greeder, Miller, Attorney-Scott McDonald, Maintenance Superintendent-Rick Paulson and Clerk-Vickie Keating.

ABSENT: Marcellais.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Bohnen moved to adopt the agenda as presented, Greeder seconded the motion and the agenda was adopted.

MINUTES OF THE JANUARY, 2010 MEETING

Miller moved to approve the minutes as pre-read, Bohnen seconded the motion and the motion passed.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments at the February meeting.

LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

Matt Wieland attended the Council Meeting and introduced himself as the sergeant the officers report to in the Mahtomedi and Willernie area. He asked if there were any problems or concerns in Willernie.

The mayor explained that Willernie has had some trouble with snow mobiles and the u-turns in front of City Hall. The four way stop at County 12 and Wildwood Road is another area of concern for the City. Sergeant Wieland will pass on the information to the officers in the area so that they can watch for violations.

RESOLUTION FOR CERTIFICATION CORRECTION

Parent explained an error was made on a water certification for 412 Paddington and the resolution will correct the error so the resident will not be charged for the incorrect amount on the taxes.

Parent moved to pass the resolution to correct the certification on 412 Paddington, Miller seconded the motion and the motion passed.

CABLE COMMISSION GRANTS

The Willernie City Council appreciates the fact that there are grants available for cities that televise their council meetings; however, Willernie is not interested in televising the meetings at this time.

ANIMAL CONTROL CONTRACT

Scott reviewed the Animal Control contract and would like to add a sentence under item 17 stating that any surcharge shall be limited to the amount by which the average cost per gallon exceeds \$3.15 times the number of gallons used while on patrol in the City of Willernie.

The motion to accept the Animal Control Contract with the above correction was made by Parent. Greeder seconded the motion and the motion passed.

CELL TOWER

The mayor explained that the comprehensive plan for the City of Willernie has been accepted as presented except for two areas that need some additional information. There is one section in the comprehensive plan that states cell towers will not be allowed for at least the next ten years.

Due to the comprehensive plan update the Council agreed that the tower will not be allowed in the City of Willernie in the year 2010.

SNOW MOBILE ORDINANCE

The Council reviewed the snowmobile ordinance Scott presented and added no motorized vehicles in the parks, no operation of a motorized vehicle or other vehicles without a valid driver's license and the elimination of the wording containing school grounds.

Parent moved to accept the snowmobile ordinance with the above corrections and Greeder seconded the motion. The motion passed.

420 PADDINGTON

Scott has the packet ready to submit to the court on the hazardous conditions of 420 Paddington. Nothing has changed on this house, no one is living in the house and the water has been turned off.

Since nothing has changed on the property, Scott will submit the information to the courts during February.

COUNTY 12-244

There have not been any meetings on the County 12-244 intersection since the last Council meeting.

RICK REPORT

The salt the City was issued is holding, the plowing has been going smoothly and hopefully the snow will be done by the middle of March.

APPROVAL OF BILLS

Miller moved to approve the bills, Bohnen seconded the motion and the motion passed.

ADJOURNMENT

Bohnen moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:25 p.m., Miller seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
