CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
NOVEMBER 20, 2013**

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Bohnen moved to accept the agenda as presented, Baglio seconded the motion and the agenda was approved.

MINUTES OF THE OCTOBER MEETING

Baglio moved to accept the October minutes as pre-read, Bohnen seconded the motion and the motion passed.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

No residents were present for public comments.

LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

The Washington County Officers did not attend the November meeting.

LIQUOR LICENSE – HANGER ROOM

Mr. Miller did not attend the November meeting so his liquor license was not discussed.

RESOLUTION FOR COUNTY 12 AND STILLWATER ROAD

Parent met with the Mayor and engineer of Mahtomedi, along with the Washington County Representatives to discuss the turn off of 244 onto County 12 by the Piccadilly. Both Mayors requested some action at this intersection due to the number of traffic accidents occurring at this site. The agreement was to put some asphalt down to shift the turn lane over and open up the line of vision.

When highway 36 opens the amount of traffic on 244 and County 12 will decrease, however, it may remain heavier than it was before 36 closed.

Washington County requested the cooperation of the cities to do a study on the corridor and asked for a resolution to make this happen. The study will be both for short and long term suggestions.

A motion to approve the resolution was made by Parent, Baglio seconded the motion and the motion passed.

RENTAL LICENSE UPDATE

Scott sent out three enforcement letters and all the of the owners have contacted Jack to set up appointments for the inspections. There has still been no word for Eric Long on his rental license so Scott will follow up on that letter.

Parent then read a letter given to the Council by Jack Kramer, building inspector, on 412 Paddington. Parent suggested sending a copy of this letter to the contact at the mortgage company and the inspector for the bank has already received a copy of the letter.

EXTERIOR STORAGE ORDINANCE/SOLICITORS ORDINANCE

The exterior storage ordinance now incorporates the suggestions made by the building inspector as voted on at the October meeting.

The solicitor's ordinance was tabled until the December meeting.

GRANTS

No report was given on grants due to Miller's absence.

RICK REPORT

The last leaf pick up will be this week. The truck is ready for the plowing if the snow comes earlier than expected and everything else is running smoothly.
