CITY COUNCIL MEETING

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Tree for Milnar Park was added to the agenda under new business. Miller made the motion to approve the agenda with the addition, Bohnen seconded the motion and the motion passed.

MINUTES OF THE OCTOBER 21, 2015 MEETING

Bohnen moved to approve the October minutes as pre-read, Warren seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

TREE FOR PARK

The mayor purchased a 15 foot maple to replace the tree in the park that was removed due to oak wilt. Rick helped plant the tree in the same space as the old tree and it will bloom in two to three years.

The tree planted in remembrance of Faye died during the summer months, so the mayor will check on another plant for the park next spring.

LETTER TO MAHTOMEDI

The Council reviewed the letter to be sent to Mahtomedi concerning the credit due to the City. The mayor went through the sequence of events since June with Scott to be included in the letter.

The Council gave the mayor permission to sign and mail the letter after reviewing the final draft with Scott.

CHICKEN ORDINANCE

Miller asked to table the chicken ordinance until December in order to gather more information.

412 PADDINGTON

Bohnen visited with the new owner of 412 Paddington, however, he was not sure how much the new owner understood.

The recommendation of the Council is that this house cannot be occupied without a plan presented to the Council and approved to make sure it is a safe, clean structure.

420 PADDINGTON

Mr. Tachney has applied for a demolition permit to remove 420 Paddington. He now is working with the Minnesota Pollution Control to make sure the asbestos is removed safely.

GRANTS

Miller met with Matt Dean and Peter Fischer's assistant on October 30 to discuss available grants for Willernie. Both parties are researching grants for 2016.

RICK REPORT

The leaf vac is finished for this season and the snow plough is on the truck and ready for winter.

Rick wanted to thank Bob Holly for taking the wood out of the park and cleaning up the area.

APPROVAL OF THE BILLS

Baglio moved to approve the bills, Bohnen seconded the motion and the bills were approved.

ADJOURNMENT

Bohnen moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:50 p.m. Warren seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
