SNOWMOBILES ON STILLWATER ROAD

The snowmobile ordinance in Willernie allows snowmobiles on the streets as long as they are going slowly. If the snowmobiles are going faster than 35 miles an hour the officers can ticket the driver. The sidewalk on Stillwater Road is a path to the trail and the snowmobiles are allowed access to this area.

The snowmobiles must follow the rules of the road.

Scott brought some information on the snowmobile guidelines that will be maintained at the City office.

WATER UPDATE

There is a meeting on Thursday, February 18th with the Mahtomedi City Administrator, the finance director and two council members. The Mayor will report back to the Council on the outcome of the meeting.

The installation of new water meters is a necessity for Willernie and this will be done as soon as funds are available. It will cost approximate 45 thousand dollars for the meters and installation Willernie.

GRANTS

Miller is compiling a cost sheet for the grants that Willernie has applied for in the past and will keep the Council informed of the outcome.
