CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
MAY 18, 2016**

**ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA**

Miller moved to accept the agenda as presented, Warren seconded the motion and the agenda was approved.

**APPROVAL OF THE APRIL MINUTES**

Baglio moved to approve the April minutes as pre-read. Warren seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER**

The officer assigned to Willernie was attending SWAT training so the substitute officer attended the meeting to check on the City.

There was a car theft on the corner of Charing and Wildwood during the month and the ticket on Sargent was a concern.

The normal concerns on Chatham and Wildwood Road were discussed and the officer will inform the regular duty officer of the concerns so patrols can be put in these areas.

**WATER UPDATE**

Parent explained that Willernie will give the water usage reports to Mahtomedi but Willernie will have its own docking station and readings. There was discussion on Peachtree, however, the Mayor checked with the auditors and Peachtree is an up to date accounting system.

Willernie has not received the bill from Mahtomedi for the last quarter usage due to the confusion on the billing. Willernie is tier 1 and should not be charged 40 cents more than Mahtomedi residents. These items will be discussed at the meeting on Monday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>, with Mahtomedi.

### **PARKING ON SARGENT**

The sign is not correct on Sargent so Rick will order the correct signs. Scott will make sure the ticket received will be dismissed due to the placement of the sign and Warren will contact the sheriff's office to explain that new signs are on order so no tickets should be issued until the correct parking signs are installed.

### **GRANTS**

Miller is talking to the legislature representatives and is waiting on the funding bill at the present time. Nothing has been passed as of today's date.

The Legion donated the usual funds for the Willernie Parks.

### **RICK REPORT**

Bob Holly is taking down dead trees and cleaning up Milnar Park. The City wants him to know they appreciate all his hard work on the park.

The beach condo association has asked to plant some flowers along the fence on the beach that are native to the area. If they become too large they will be removed but it should enhance the area.

### **APPROVAL OF THE BILLS**

Miller moved to approve the bills. Bohnen seconded the motion and the motion passed.

**ADJOURNMENT**

Bohnen moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:28 p.m. Baglio seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
