

**OF WILLERNIE
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
DECEMBER 17, 2025**

PRESENT: Baglio, Soderlund, De Jong, Cook, Siver, Consultant-Gary Brown, Attorney-Tori Kelm, Maintenance Superintendent-Ken Johnson and Clerk Vickie Keating.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Soderlund moved to approve the agenda, Siver seconded the motion and the agenda was approved.

APPROVAL OF THE NOVEMBER 2025 MINUTES

Soderlund moved to approve the minutes as pre-read, Baglio seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

WASHINGTON COUNTY SHERIFF

Officers Lauryn and Henry came to the meeting and gave a monthly update for the city. Nothing except traffic stops and a few Dwi's – during the month.

The officers asked citizens to call the sheriff's office if anything unusual happens in the city.

The council explained that cars have been parking in the public parking area allowed at the park and leaving the vehicles there for extended periods of time.

Milford is a narrow street, and the vehicles cannot park on that street. Ken asked the officers to ticket the cars if they are parked on Milford tomorrow.

ROAD RESOLUTION

This resolution is for a winter parking ban. The winter parking ordinances will be reviewed in the future so the resolution could be posted as needed.

Gary suggested reviewing the parking situations for all seasons in the city. Snow emergency is usually 2 to 3 inches of snow – Willernie's is 1 inch.

De Jong moved to pass Resolution 2025-11. No second was made to the motion, so the motion did not pass.

Tori suggested a special meeting to discuss the parking ordinance as soon as possible.

WATER INCREASE

De Jong moved to take \$75 for the special assessment off the water bill and increase the user fee by \$10.00 to match the water supply expense. Baglio seconded the motion and the motion passed.

KEN REPORT

Webster reported a problem with a drain, but it is not on city property.

Webster and Chippenham complained about a clogged sewer line. Roter Router fixed the problem, and the owner requested payment from the city, however, it was explained this is not on city property and it is the homeowner's responsibility.

Ken will check the drain on Clyde and Donegal.

WILLERNIE UPDATE

There are no new updates. The newsletter will be sent out in the December water bill. The tree information will be included in the newsletter.

Baglio reported meeting with the Waste Management representative and explained a truck goes down Faversham for three residents. It might be wise to change Faversham to one way from South to North to eliminate traffic on this road.

APPROVAL OF THE BILLS

Soderlund moved to approve the bills, Siver seconded the motion and the bills were approved.

ADJOURNMENT

Soderlund moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 p.m. Siver seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned.
